NEW UNIFORM REQUIREMENT

All Soldiers can now wear the U.S. flag insignia on the right shoulder of their utility uniform, as a continued reminder that the Army is engaged in a war at home and abroad.

The uniform item was approved Feb. 11, and all Soldiers have until Oct. 1, 2005 to get the insignia sewn on their uniforms.

The only flag authorized for wear on the uniform is the reverse field flag in red, white and blue. These flags are available at all Clothing & Sales Stores and are available online at www.aafes.com

The flag is sewn 1/2 inch below the shoulder seam. If a combat patch is also placed on the right shoulder, the flag is sewn 1/8 inch below the combat patch.
